## Southside High School Summer Sports Camp Day Information

#### **Date and Time**

The gym lobby doors will open at 7:30am for check in. At this time, you will receive your schedule for the day, a map of the school/fields, and names and pictures of all coaches. All students should be off campus no later than 15 minutes after the Sports Camp Day has ended its last session. Students must stay on campus for the entire duration of the event.

#### **Transportation**

There will be a bus running to and from S.W. Snowden Elementary to aid parents with the distance from Aurora to Chocowinity. SHS will not be responsible for students who are left behind, nor are we able to provide transportation. Students who are not riding the SWS bus will be responsible for a ride to and from SHS. Please see the Transportation Form for more information.

#### **Activities and Sports Provided**

Girls Activities Included: volleyball, basketball, track and field, soccer, softball, weightroom, and team-building competition activities

Boys Activities Included: football, soccer, basketball, track and field, baseball, wrestling, and golf.

#### Lunch

Your \$15 registration fee covers lunch and a small gatorade. Students will be expected to bring their own reusable water bottle and a snack if needed. If your child has any allergies or dietary needs, please make sure it is indicated on the Registration and Health Form. Students are NOT allowed to leave campus for food. If they do so, they will not be allowed to return, and their registration fee will not be refunded.

#### **Other Information**

- 1. Students are not allowed to leave campus during the event. If they do so, they will not be allowed to return. Southside High School, Beaufort County Schools, and other parties involved are not responsible or liable for any student who chooses to leave the property, or any injury, illness, or legal aftermath of events that happens after they have left. If a student needs a snack or other items, it will need to be dropped off to them.
- 2. Students are expected to participate in the activities, show good sportsmanship, and follow SHS and BCS rules. Inappropriate behavior and activities will not be tolerated and may result in removal from school property, parent pickup, and other consequences depending on the situation.
- 3. Rising 6th-Rising 9th graders will be required to attend sessions for all sports and activities. They are encouraged to participate, but they will not be forced to do so. If a student does not wish to participate, they may sit on the sidelines and observe. Trying new things can be difficult and sometimes stressful, so please do what you are comfortable with! High school students will be given a list of sessions for Rising 10th-Rising 12th graders and may attend the sessions they wish. If they have an open session, they may feel free to go into the weightroom, attend an FCA meeting, or help with a middle school session of a sport they play.

### Southside High School Summer Sports Camp Accident Waiver and Release of Liability Form

**If using the S.W. Snowden bus**, please note the bus will arrive at SWS at 7AM and will leave at 7:10 AM. Due to the check in process, the bus cannot wait on late students to arrive. The bus <u>will leave SHS 15 minutes after</u> the end of the last session and will arrive approximately 25 minutes after departure. SHS is not responsible for students who fail to get on the bus back to Snowden within this 15 minute period, and will need to be picked up by a parent or legal guardian.

If your child is being dropped off and picked up from Southside, please note the doors open at 7:30 AM for the check in process. During this time students will receive a wristband with their group's color, their schedule for the day, and be directed to their first location. It is crucial to show up on time so that students can get the most out of their first session and relieve the anxiety of finding their correct location.

Students should not be dropped off and left unattended on campus before the gym lobby doors open at 7:30am. Students should wait in the car with their parents until this time. Southside High School is not responsible for unattended students on campus before the event starts at 7:30am.
