

SOUTHSIDE HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE - BCS Board Policy 4316, 4316-R

The BCS board believes that the dress and personal appearance of students greatly affect their academic performance and their interaction with other students.

Inappropriate, indecent or vulgar graphics or messages, including anything not permitted by law to minors, is prohibited on any article of clothing.

Styles or attire frequently associated with intimidation, violence or violent groups are not allowed.

Pants, Skirts, Shorts, Jumpers, Dresses, Skorts, Capris

- Garments cannot be shorter than 3 inches above the knee
- Approved shirt or top is required when wearing a jumper
- No tears, holes or rips above the knee that exposes skin
- No exposed undergarments at any time. Pants cannot be sagging
- Pajama pants are prohibited

<u>Shoes</u>

- Some type of footwear must be worn at all times
- No spike heels or bedroom shoes

<u>Shirts</u>

- Shirts may be any color, long or short sleeve, and do not require a collar
- Sleeveless, bare midriff, strapless, or spaghetti strapped shirts are not permitted
- Form fitting spandex material and nylon are prohibited
- Oversized, undersized, and skintight garments will not be tolerated

<u>Coats</u>

• Coats must not hang past the top inseam of the pants

<u>Head</u>

 No head coverings can be worn at any time. This includes hats, hoodies, scarves, bandanas, and shower caps

Blankets, pillows and other bedding materials are not permitted
