Course Objective: English 3 is an 11th grade class. Students will explore a wide variety of literature and articles from different perspectives. Students are expected to read and write daily. The course is a survey of United States literature and culture including recognition and understanding of various literary genres and terms. Written, oral, critical, and creative responses to literary and nonfiction selections are required. The study of grammar is taught through the writing process. Vocabulary study is an important part of the course.
