WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL PARKING AGREEMENT

Beaufort County Schools provides transportation for students to and from the school to which they are assigned based on residence. Since student transportation is provided by the school district, the operation of a motor vehicle by students on campus is a privilege. Retention of the privilege is based on compliance with state motor vehicle laws, board policies and regulations governing students.

Beaufort County Schools: Code of Student Conduct

Rule 13 VEHICLE USE (Responsibility/Citizenship/Good Judgment)

A. Reckless Vehicle Use UB: Other School Defined Offense; UB: Disruptive Behavior: A student will not operate any motorized or self-propelled vehicle on school grounds in a manner that is a threat to health and/or safety, or a disruption to the educational process. Driving to school is a privilege, which may be limited or revoked at any time by the school principal.

B. Vehicle Parking on Campus UB: Inappropriate Item on School Property: A student will not park a motor vehicle on school premises unless he/she has complied with all school vehicle parking requirements. Parking permits must be visibly displayed and vehicles must be parked only in assigned spaces. Unauthorized vehicles may be towed.

Permit Purchase Requirements:

Students desiring to purchase a permit must:

- Present a completed and signed copy of this WHS Parking Agreement
- -Have valid NC driver's license.
- -Have no student debt to the school
- -Pay \$50 parking fee (\$25 if purchased after 1/02/2024)
- -Choose numbered parking spot for the year

Permit Purchase Dates: Permits will be purchased in the front office, 9am-3pm.

<u>Senior parking permits</u>: Monday August 21 <u>Underclassmen permits</u>: Tuesday August 22 and Wednesday August 23 *New drivers must purchase a parking permit prior to parking on campus*

Liability:

Washington High School is not responsible for any vehicle parked on campus. School staff cannot guarantee any vehicle's safekeeping or its contents while on campus.

-Any damage to a vehicle on campus will be reported to SRO and or the Washington Police department.

-School administration will assist students with any complaints

Parking Lot Regulations

-All Beaufort County Code of Conduct rules/regulations apply to the student parking.

-Vehicles must be parked ONLY in assigned numbered space between the white lines.

- Illegally parked cars may be booted or towed at the owner's expense.

-The speed limit on campus is 15 MPH. Excessive speed or unsafe vehicle operation will result in suspension of driving privileges and report to law enforcement.

-Student parking permits cannot be transferred, sold, or shared.

-Students may not go to their cars during the school day without permission from an administrator/front office.

-Students may not leave campus without being checked out by a parent/guardian in the front office (Out of School Suspension & Lose of Parking Privilege)

Consequences

-Any violation of parking lot regulations is subject to disciplinary action.

-Serious infractions will be reported to school SRO or Washington Police Department.

-Failure to abide by WHS regulations or state regulations may result in short term or permanent loss of the privilege to operate a motor vehicle on campus.

-NO refund will be issued for revoked parking permits.

-Washington High School reserves the right to revoke a permit at any time.

-Determination of disciplinary action for any violation will be the responsibility of the school principal, assistant principal, or SRO.
