- Wear cap/gown/white stole/school-issued tassel
- Meet at WHS bus parking lot.
- Bus leaves at 8:20 a.m. You **MUST** ride the bus.

SENIOR AWARDS NIGHT ~ Thursday, May 30, 2024 at 6 p.m. in the WHS Performing Arts Center

- Attendance is required to walk on graduation day. **Seniors should schedule time off from work.**
- No admission after the Processional ends. Except for medical concerns, exiting and returning is not permitted.
- Children five and over are welcome.
- Guests park in the student parking lot. Seniors park in the bus parking lot.

Senior Awards Procedures

- ❖ **Lineup:** Seniors report to the gymnasium at 5:15 p.m. for attendance and line up with your homeroom teacher. Homeroom signs will be posted on the bleachers. *Student speakers will meet in the PAC lobby at 5:45 p.m.*
- ❖ **Processional/Recessional:** Marshals will lead seniors into the auditorium. Seniors will remain standing until all seniors have been ushered into the auditorium. Gentlemen will remove caps for prayers and replace them once seated. When the award ceremony has ended, marshals will lead seniors out.
- ❖ **Award/Scholarship Recipients:** If a senior receives an award and/or a scholarship, the principal/assistant principal will call the student's name, and the student will stand. A marshal will take the award or scholarship to the recipient. The student will remain standing until the marshal delivers the award, and then sit back down. A thank you note should be written by the award recipient after the ceremony.
- ❖ **Attire:**
 - **Gentlemen:** Wear a button-up dress shirt, a tie, and long pants (black, blue, or khaki) with dress shoes.
 - **Ladies:** Wear a blouse with a skirt, a blouse with pants, or a dress. Wear comfortable dress shoes. (For graduation, heels will stick in the turf and make walking difficult.)
 - **Only professional attire is acceptable. No jeans, shorts, leggings, sweatpants, pajama pants, t-shirts, tank tops, crop tops, crocs, flip-flops, tennis shoes, slides, or bedroom shoes. You will be pulled out of line for violations of dress code.**
 - Wear navy blue cap/gown/white stole/tassel (school-issued tassel should hang on the right side). Wear caps correctly; no décor is permitted on caps.
 - **Note:** Cords and stoles not achieved through Washington High School or school affiliated honor societies or groups should not be worn during the ceremony.

GRADUATION PRACTICE ~ Friday, June 7, 2024 at 11 a.m.

- Attendance is required to walk on graduation day. **Seniors should schedule time off from work.**
- Park in the student parking lot.
- Wear comfortable attire. (Do not bring cap and gown to practice.)
- Bring water.
- Report to your homeroom teacher in the gymnasium for attendance and line up.
- Practice consists of walking in and out of the stadium and having names read aloud.
- Tickets and WHS issued stoles, cords, and honor tassels will be distributed after graduation practice has concluded. **You will receive 10 tickets for outdoor graduation and 4 for indoor graduation.**
- You will not receive your graduation tickets until all school debts have been cleared.

GRADUATION ~ Saturday, June 8, 2024 at 8:30 a.m. at WHS J.G. "Choppy" Wagner Stadium

- Seniors are issued 10 yellow outdoor tickets and 4 purple indoor tickets for graduation. Guest entry to the ceremony is by ticket only. Indoor/outdoor tickets are not interchangeable.
- Seniors should schedule time off from work.
- Guests should park in the student parking lot and arrive prior to 8:15 a.m. for seating.
- Guest entry will not be permitted after the ceremony begins.
- Guests should sit on the bleachers on either side of the field.
- Standing along the fence line, on the track, or in the area by the fieldhouse is prohibited.
- Medical and accessible seating will be available in designated areas.
- Video arrangements are via Mr. Randy Walker at G.W. Walker & Sons.

Senior Graduation Procedures

- ❖ **Parking:** Park in the bus parking lot (your cap/gown unit is your parking pass).
- ❖ **Lineup:** Seniors report to the gymnasium at 7:45 a.m. for attendance and line up with your homeroom teacher. Homeroom signs will be posted on the bleachers.
- ❖ **Attire:**
 - **Gentlemen:** Wear a button-up dress shirt, a tie, and long pants (black, blue, or khaki) with dress shoes.
 - **Ladies:** Wear a blouse with a skirt, a blouse with pants, or a dress. Wear comfortable dress shoes. (For graduation, heels will stick in the turf and make walking difficult.)
