HOME BOUND SERVICES

Homebound services aim to provide tutorial and instructional assistance for students to maintain academic success, including individualized assistance for non-exceptional children with disabilities.

START

School counselor becomes aware of student who may need HB services and notifies SSC of possible need for HB referral

Starting Question:

- EC case manager obtain parent consent and physician's statement
- IEP Meeting is held
- IEP Team follows up with Director of EC Services, Kim Gibbs
- Review of IEP based on length of time in medical documentation

- IEP Team Meeting
- consider all less restrictive options on the continuum of placements – we must go through the continuum of service options
- Information forwarded to Director of EC Services, Kim Gibbs. Gibbs provide information to HB Coordinator for teacher assignment
- IEP reviewed every 30 days
