Senior Picture Information: Please make sure to get your \$50 paid by Tuesday, February 28, 2023. March 4, 2023, the photographer will be meeting with students during their scheduled slot at Ribeye's in Washington, NC starting at 2 pm. Students will be getting <u>2 poses with their graduation gowns, and one</u> <u>dress/casual pose.</u> Please sign up for a slot A.S.A.P. Payment of \$50 is due by February 24, 2023. May 1st: The deadline to let Ms. Bonner, know if you are having difficulty accessing attire for the graduation ceremony.

Graduation Practice: June 16, 2023. Students must be present at 10am. A lunch will be provided after practice. Tickets will be handed out at the end of the practice on this day.

Graduation Date/Time: June 17, 2023, at 11 am. Students must be present at 9:30 am. Parents may drop them off then and return for graduation at 11 am.

How to Dress for Graduation (under the gown): Men are required to wear dark trousers and a white dress shirt and tie under their gowns. Shoes need to be a dark color (brown or black). Women usually wear a lightweight dress (slightly above the knees) or a blouse and a skirt that is shorter than the gown, so it does not hang below the robe. High heels may be worn but be sure that you walk up and down the stairs without falling. Please do not wear flip-flops, as they are not in keeping with dress attire. Thanks!
