

Beaufort County Schools Title I Parent Involvement Plan Chocowinity Primary School 2023-2024



Program Narrative

An annual public meeting will be held to inform parents at Chocowinity Primary School about the Title I Program and parents' rights to be involved in the decisions affecting their children. A parent survey will be conducted in the spring semester of each school year in an effort to gather information relevant to parent needs and concerns. Based on these results, parent workshops and meetings will be scheduled annually. Notification letters will be sent home to parents about upcoming meeting dates and times. The dates and times of the meetings will also be displayed on the school's social media sites and school marquee. Individual teacher web pages and Remind will be utilized in relaying information concerning homework assignments and other class news. Grade levels will utilize student folders as a tool for improving home/school communication.

Parent representatives from the community will serve as members of the Chocowinity Primary School School Improvement Team to plan, implement, review, and approve elements of the School Improvement Plan, including all Title I components.

Providing Timely Information

Progress reports will be sent home once per 9 weeks. Conferences will be held as needed to discuss student progress and concerns. Three quarterly Parent Nights will be hosted for parents to pick up report cards. During Parent Nights, parents will be able to schedule conferences with their child's teacher to discuss student progress and concerns.

A Curriculum Night will be held once a year to inform parents about the North Carolina Statewide Student Accountability Standards and the ESEA legislation. Information regarding student expectations, promotion requirements, End of Grade Testing, and Benchmark Testing will be discussed as well. Parent conferences will be used to discuss individual student proficiencies and assessment results.

A Parent Survey will be conducted in the spring of each year to assess parental satisfaction and concerns with the content of Chocowinity Primary School Improvement Plan. The School Improvement Team will evaluate suggestions for improvement and make changes to the program as deemed necessary.

School/Parent Compacts

A school/home learning compact will be distributed to every parent at Open House or sent home with children the first day of school. This learning compact outlines the responsibilities for high student academic achievement to be shared by the student, parent, teacher, and administration.

Providing Parent Assistance

Results of Parent Surveys will be used by the School Improvement Team to determine the types of support parents need as parents, students, and staff work together to increase student achievement. Strategies will be shared through parent conferences, parent nights, and parent handouts. Training sessions will be offered to parents based on the needs expressed in the Parent Survey.

Information regarding parent conferences, meetings, and special events will be sent home to parents in a format that uses language parents can understand. Translations will be available for non-English parents.

Educating School Personnel

The School Improvement Team, Principal, and CPS staff members will implement strategies to improve communication between parents and school personnel. This will include activities such as parent all calls, parent meetings, student/parent data conferences, along with utilizing Remind 101 and social media posts to inform parents and families.

Recognition Ceremonies

Parent Survey results have indicated that recognition ceremonies are valuable to them. We will continue to recognize students for various accomplishments this school year. Students will be recognized at the end of each nine weeks for things such as: attendance, honor roll, positive behaviors, and improvements in grades and character.
