**2022 SUMMER BUS WASHING REQUIREMENTS**

Dates: July 18-August 5<sup>th</sup>

Times: 6:30 AM – 4:00 PM (Unless different times are agreed upon)

Location: Bus Parking Lot behind Beaufort County School Bus Garage

Buses: 135 Total Buses (113 Yellow School Buses & 22 White Activity Buses)

1-Wash outside of buses, including the top of bus. (Do NOT stand on top of buses, safety steps provided)(Use a truck brush, not a pressure washer.)

2-Clean step well.

3-Wipe dash area with all-purpose cleaner.

4-Wash all windows inside and outside of buses with glass cleaner and wipe dry.

5-Wipe inside rail above windows with all-purpose cleaner or soapy water.

6-Wipe walls of buses under windows with all-purpose cleaner or soapy water.

7-Wipe inside of bus top with all-purpose cleaner or soapy water.

8-Wipe all seats with all-purpose cleaner and wipe dry. Make sure ALL MOLD is removed.

9-Remove trash and items from bus.

10-Mop all bus floors with clean soapy water.

**NO WATER HOSES IN BUS FLOORS OR WATER AROUND DASH AREA!**
