**Doors will open at 1:15 p.m.** Please ask your guests to arrive by 1:45 so that they can be seated prior to the seniors lining up. Seating is on a first-come, first-served basis.

You and your guests should use the bathroom prior to 1:45. No one will be admitted after the program begins. This includes people who exit the auditorium to go to the restroom. Anyone who exits will not be allowed to reenter

#### **Guest Attire**

While SHS doesn't regulate what guests wear to graduation, guests are encouraged to honor the graduates with an appropriate selection of apparel. Please request that your guests dress appropriately. Also, please notify Brittany Lane if a guest needs a special seating accommodation or an interpreter.

#### **Outbursts & Applause**

All attendees will be asked to **hold applause until all graduates have been introduced**. It is distracting to the ceremony and rude to other graduates for outbursts to occur during the ceremony.

#### **CAP & GOWNS AND HONOR CORD PROTOCOL**

A certain standard of dress is required whenever the cap and gown are worn. Students should wear only honor cords that Southside High School provides.

Caps are designed to be worn flat on the head. The front of the cap is to rest on the forehead.

**Throwing and decorating caps is prohibited.** If you have any doubts about the appropriateness of apparel, ask Mrs. Lane.

#### **ADMISSION TO GRADUATION**

Each senior will receive **six (6) auditorium** tickets. You will also receive **two (2) overflow** tickets for the overflow room, where your guests can view the ceremony in real time as it is being projected.

Need extra tickets? After graduation practice on **Friday**, **June 16**th, all extra tickets will be raffled off. *Please* indicate if any of your guests will need special seating considerations due to being confined in a wheelchair.

#### Small Children at Graduation

Small children can often be a source of distraction to the participants and guests. They usually will not understand the significance of the occasion. However, any small child/baby brought to the ceremony <u>must</u> have a ticket. This also includes babies who are held in arms. Please consider the enjoyment of all who attend and make childcare arrangements for very young children.

## **CAMERAS AND PHONES**

- All cell phones should be on silent.
- Handheld cameras and video cameras are allowed.
- Tripods are not allowed.

#### SENIOR DEBTS & GRADUATION TICKET PICK UP

Graduates may pick up tickets from the main office after graduation practice if all school debts are cleared—this includes all books, uniforms, and loaned equipment.
