In Pursuant to the North Carolina Division of Health Services Asbestos in Building Program under 40 CFR 763.93 (g) (4), it is required that parents, teachers, and employees, or organizations of these groups be notified in writing annually of the Beaufort County Schools updated Asbestos Management Plan, its location, and availability.

Under this program periodic surveillances of asbestos materials in all facilities are conducted semi-annually with walk-through inspections scheduled every three years by an accredited asbestos inspector or management planner. The inspector or planner then reviews the results of the re-inspection and recommends actions we should take to safely manage each of the identified asbestos materials in our buildings; if any.

Our last re-inspection was conducted this year and no significant changes in the asbestos materials were noted during the re-inspection. All asbestos materials were found to be in satisfactory condition and we plan to continue to manage them in place, as recommended by the accredited inspector.

The results of these surveillances and re-inspections are also made available, as part of the facilities Asbestos Management Plan Review, to the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services Division of Public Health and are on file in the school's administrative office in the Asbestos Handbook.
